Although in *Things*, the interior spaces are densely decorated, Correia focuses our eye on those meaningful or symbolic objects that present clues regarding the lives of the families who treasure them.

These photographs portray two European realities, both which are populated by the craft and art of old world Modernity. Despite the beautiful specificity of the compositions, these photographs go beyond documentary photography. In *De Jong De-Humidifier*, aspects of traditional genres such as portraiture and still life are combined with references to vernacular photographic practices and to the archive. Correia employs clever juxtapositions of images, rich layering of objects and doubling of photographs to address conceptual issues regarding representation and cultural identity.
