A.I.R. Gallery is pleased to announce a group show of work by the gallery artists.

In celebration of the year 2000, as many of our conversations revolve around the musings characteristic of the end of a year, a century and a millennium, the A.I.R. Gallery artists present work which explores the idea of change in their own careers. Each artist was asked to exhibit a piece that demonstrates a "turning point" in concept, material or process in their work.

The result is a show that ranges from the whimsical, Sylvia Netzer's oversized ceramic 45 R.P.M. Adapter, literally a turning point, to the serious in Louise McCagg's solemn Rilke Boxes. It also ranges from the abstract, Jessie Nebraska Gifford's colorful MS Series interpreting her recent MRIs and Lenore Goldberg's subtle geometric manipulations in Flower, to the representational in Regina Granne's precisely executed still life series, Sticks and Stones. The exhibit also demonstrates the gallery artists' forays into new media and processes in Daria Dorosh's digital prints on linen mounted hemp, Stephanie Bernheim's oil painting on awning canvas, Michi Itami's carved wood relief and Elke Solomon's painted stencil, both the tool and the product of her work.
