NEW YORK, NY: A.I.R. is pleased to announce an exhibition of sculpture by Elizabeth Hill. The show opens April 21 and continues through May 9, 1998. There will be an opening reception on Tuesday, April 21st beginning at 6 P.M.

This is Hill's first solo exhibition in New York of her "American Votives" series. This biographical work spans four years culminating in the creation of two large dancing dolls made totally of fabric. Other works in the exhibition are carved in stone or wood and painted with gold leaf and encaustic, then further embellished with skillfully crafted garments.

Hill began her career as a sculptor after 21 years as a pediatric nurse. Sculpture emerged as a means of healing and understanding her own life.

Ms. Hill is currently living and working in Findhorn, Scotland where she is involved in community arts, performance work, and developing her skills in puppetry.
