A.I.R. Gallery is pleased to announce "Cut Paper", an exhibition of work by New York City artist Jane Greer. Well known for her sculpture and paintings, Ms. Greer will devote an entire show to her cut paperworks. The public and the press are invited to a reception for the artist on Tuesday, December 5 from 6:00 to 8:00PM.

Ms. Greer's works with/on paper are silhouetted forms cut from colored Japanese paper and mounted on a black background. So confident are the incisions, and rendered with such ease, they take on an unnatural definition, as if produced with a laser. However, it is by Greer's mastery of her tools and of the meditative concentration required to produce fluid line that she achieves this striking tension between strength and delicacy.

Seeming to be conjured from a biologist's handbook, a child's reader or an adult's nightmare, the revealed creatures form intricate compositions, often occupying each other's negative space. The result is an intuitivly rendered and imaginatively conceived menagerie.

Jane Greer's work has been featured in solo exhibitions at Simon Capstick Fine Arts, Franklin Furnace, and Lehman College, among many others, as well as in group exhibitions at Kenkeleba Gallery, Ronald Feldman Fine Arts, The Drawing Center and in invitational exhibitions at A.I.R.
